4D- Administration and staff will ensure information related to the school, parent programs, meetings and other activities are sent to the parents in an understandable format, and in a language that parents can understand. Parents are invited to the Open House for each grade they have a child attend, Parent/Teacher Conferences, Annual Title Meeting, and many night activities that are offered at the school monthly. The parents are informed through the weekly Tuesday folders of any upcoming events or opportunities they may participate in.

4E- Coordination with other programs:

The administration will to the extent feasible and appropriate, coordinate and integrate parent & family engagement programs and activities with Pre-Kindergarten programs, and other available community resources and programs. Watson offers a variety of assistance programs: Breakfast after the Bell, Universal Free Lunch, School Bell, Title 1 Hope, and 3 square food program, Operation School Bell, Counselor Clothing Club, and dental and medical needs referrals.

4F- Families are made aware of these programs by the counselor and correspondence sent home through the Tuesday folders and website. The nurse makes referrals through screenings of vision and hearing. The parents are made aware through the website. Teacher and staff referrals to the counselor. Title 1 Hope information is displayed in the front office. The clerk makes referrals for school bell.
